Financial Report: Financial Report was presented and future expenditure / projects discussed & approved.

- Regular purchase of hygiene supplies & health & safety resources, cleaning materials equipment and cleaning hours considered a priority by Board moving forward.
- IT Grant: Purchase of additional iPads & configuration of iPads, necessary repairs to/ replacements of staff laptops / Beebots / Vex 2020/21 pack.
- VEX: Following the cancellation of the VEX World Robotics trip, all donors were contacted and refunds issued accordingly. Donations which were generously left with the school will be spend in accordance with the wishes of the donors, following consultation.
- Outdoor Sensory / Learning Area: Board is delighted and grateful to receive a large pledge towards funding of this. With funding secured the project will now move on to the next phase of consultation with the entire school community & planning, with a view to commencing work in early 2021.
- Secretary's Office to be relocated nearer to the main door.
