We intend to continue our work on the following categories this year.

1. Literacy

In the area of Literacy we aim to work on the following:

- Comprehension
- Oral Language
- Spelling
- Creative writing using the writing genres.

In the area of Numeracy we aim to work on the following:

- Tables
- Problem Solving
- Measurement
- Mathematical sentences (Algebra)
- Assessment.
- Maths for Fun will take place in a number of classes.

In the area of parental involvement we will:

- Continue with the ATP (Action Team for Partnership).
- Hold class meetings in September.
- Support parents with oral language development in the Creche, Early Start and Junior Infants
- Support parents to help their children with literacy and numeracy.
- Support parents with the transfer of their children to 2nd level school and long term progression to 3rd level.
- Support parents of children with punctuality and attendance issues.

In the area of attendance we will:

- Follow our 8 step procedure for monitoring attendance rates.
- Continue our punctuality drive.
- Support parents in relation to improving attendance and punctuality.
- Be proactive rather than reactive to attendance issues.

We are compliant with the legislative and regulatory checklist including the school calendar, standardisation of the school year, enrolment of pupils, child protection and bullying procedures, parent/teacher and staff meetings and engagement with the planning and self-evaluation process.
